What's the Eid-UI-Fitr?

The **Eid-UI-Fitr** is a
Muslim celebration that
marks the end of the holy Month of Ramadhan



It symbolizes the end of the monthly fasting of the Muslim Ummah, in fact "Fitr" means the breaking of the fast.



Muslims wake up very early in the day of the Eid.
They have to be very clean so they have

Ghusl (bath).

They clean their teeth with siwak, a natural twig fortified with natural minerals.

Once well cleaned and perfumed (only men use perfume to go to the Masjid), Muslims wear their best clothes ever! They have some breakfast and go to the

Masjid



They are used to recite this famous Takbir along the way till the Salah:

Allaho-Akbar, Allaho-Akbar,

La ila-ha ill-lal-lah.

Allaho-Akbar, Allho-Akbar,

Wa-lilahill hamd.

The meaning is Allah is great, Allah is great, there is no god but Allah. Allah is great, Allah is great, and all praises are for Allah.

Once in the Masjid Muslims pay Zakaat-al-Fitr before Salah.

In the Masjid Muslims listen to the **Khutba** that is a sermon about special issues of Islam, then

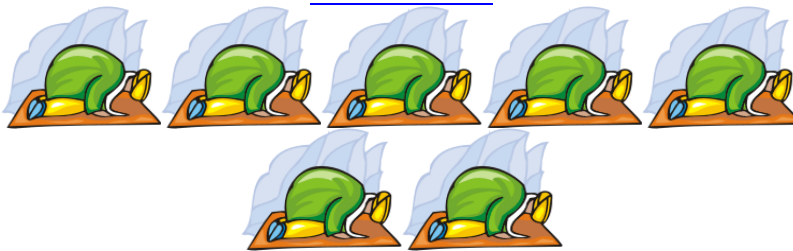
they pray

Some easy ideas for home decorating

Eid-ul-Fitr ballons

All you need is some balloons, permanent markers of nice colours

Eid-ul-Fitr guest book

Prepare a coloured paper where everyone who come to visit you could live a message, a dua'a' and his sign. Once signed they could be given a small souvenir like an Eid-ul-Fitr small greeting card.

Eid-UI-Fitr Memory box

Decorate a shoe box with coloured paper and ribbon, ask your guest to bring with them something you can keep and use for your memory box (a magazine article, or a card...).

Eid-ul-Fitr Mobile.

Print a nice picture of a Masjid from an Islamic Website, stick it on hard paper. On the back glue a coloured card with the Takbir of the Eid written on. Punch a hole and add some ribbon. Place it next to the door or where everyone can notice it.

1. The Imam speaks the Khutba, then Muslims pray and then they embrace themselves and say each other Eid Mabruk.

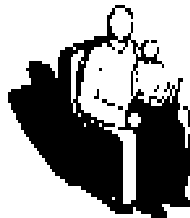
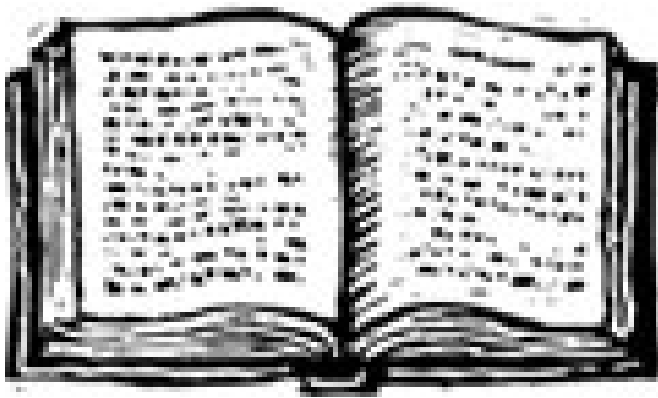


Once come back home.....
